There were fewer volunteers at the 2022 Working Bee, and we look forward to seeing them and others this year as their help certainly makes a big difference. Sharing morning tea afterwards (in the Parish hall) is a friendly and tasty occasion, with thanks to the catering by members of the parish.

We would be pleased to have a few **volunteers** join Ross, Glen and myself for one hour on a regular basis. Hours are very flexible and tools are provided. Please contact me to discuss how you might like to assist.

The **Annual Cemetery Meeting** held in July discussed the achievements made in the last 12 months including the impending copying of the old original Burial Registers (from 1850's) to minimize handling by the Genealogy SA Society and the successful installation of a new computer program to run the records of the cemetery and the Memorial Garden. My thanks to Bobbie Luks, Parish Secretary, for her help with cemetery administration and in particular her patience and persistence in changing over to the new computer system this year.

A Search can be made for a family grave via the Parish website <https://glenosmondanglicans.com.au/> Click on the tab 'About Us' / Cemetery / Search for a deceased person. A drop-down list will appear, click on St Saviours Cemetery and enter surname, then 'Search' and this will give you the location of the grave.

Mothers' Day this year was well recognised with a greater number of floral tributes than the last few years.

The information collected from families associated with the cemetery has been added to the Burnside Council library Local History Room collection.

To ensure the cemetery remains financially independent of the Parish, funds from fees are used for vegetation management, rubbish removal and general maintenance. 2022/2023 was yet another year to thank Ross Bray for his help in weed control, removing excess green waste and other very useful jobs.

In the last 12 months there have been: **Four Burials** - NB Zalkauska, RI Wyatt, K Makros, P Hardy.
Two Interment of Ashes - RB and LF Edmeades, R Porter and P Morgan.

There are over 60 plots available for re-leasing in the cemetery.

Please keep your **Lease /now called "Interment Right"** document with your other legal papers.

An Interment Right for a plot is for 50 years. See attached page for *Conditions and Fees 2023*
