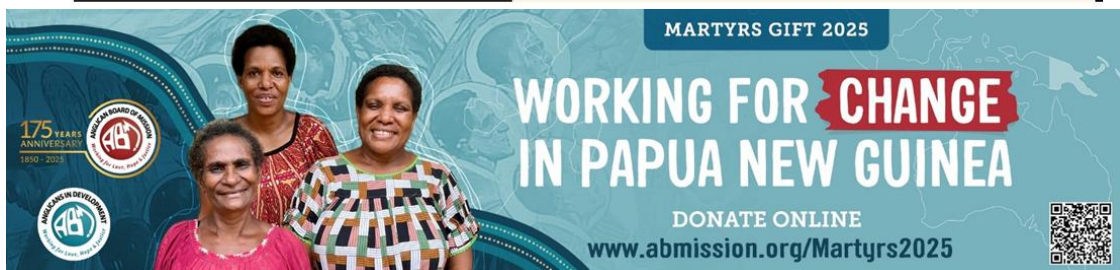


### *Pew Reflection Vignettes*

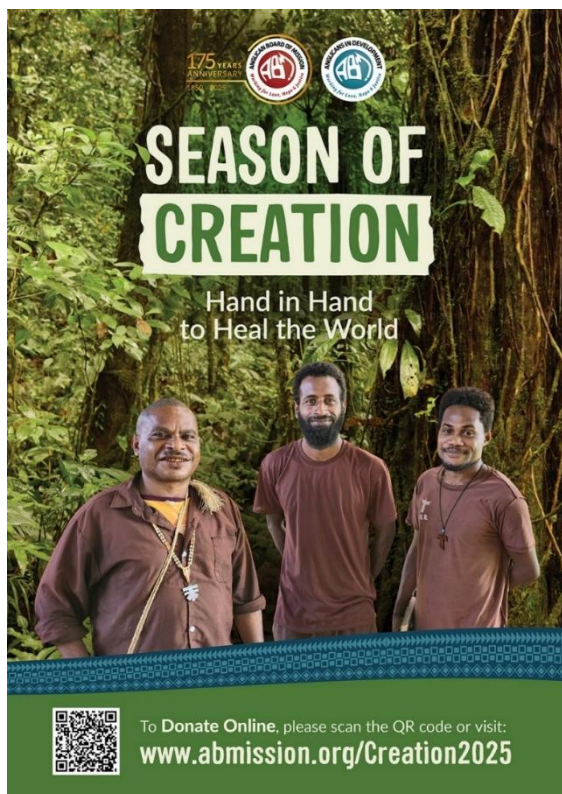

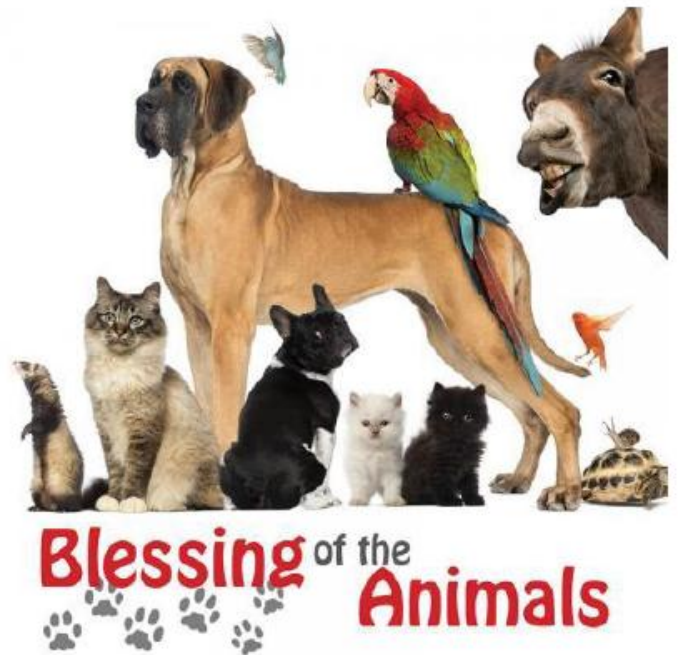
