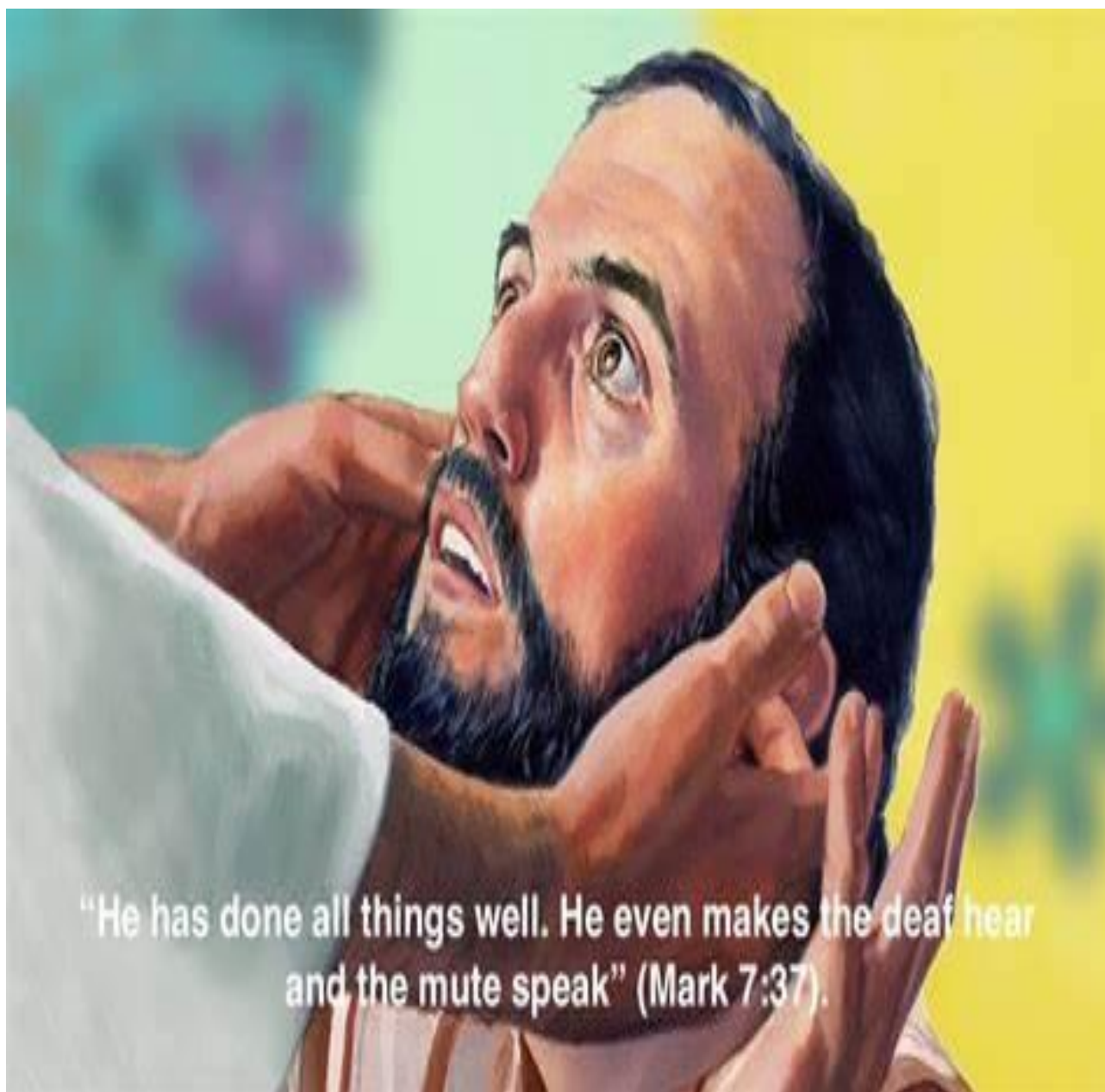

Jesus Heals a Deaf and Mute Man



Scripture

Mark 7:31-37

Jesus then left the neighbourhood of Tyre and went on through Sidon to Lake Galilee, going by way of the territory of the Ten Towns. Some people brought him a man who was deaf and could hardly speak, and they begged Jesus to place his hands on him. So Jesus took him off alone, away from the crowd, put his fingers in the man's ears, spat, and touched the man's tongue. Then Jesus looked up to heaven, gave a deep groan, and said to the man, "Ephphatha," which means, " be opened. "And immediately his ears were opened , his tongue was released, and he spoke plainly. Then Jesus ordered them to tell no one; but the more he ordered it the more zealously they proclaimed it. They were astounded beyond measure; saying, "He has done everything well: even makes the deaf to hear and the mute to speak"

The friends cared for the man so much that they wanted him to see Jesus. We, too, can help our friends to know Jesus.

Heavenly Father, we are thankful for all that you have done for us. Help us to tell our friends about Jesus, the one who does everything well. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen

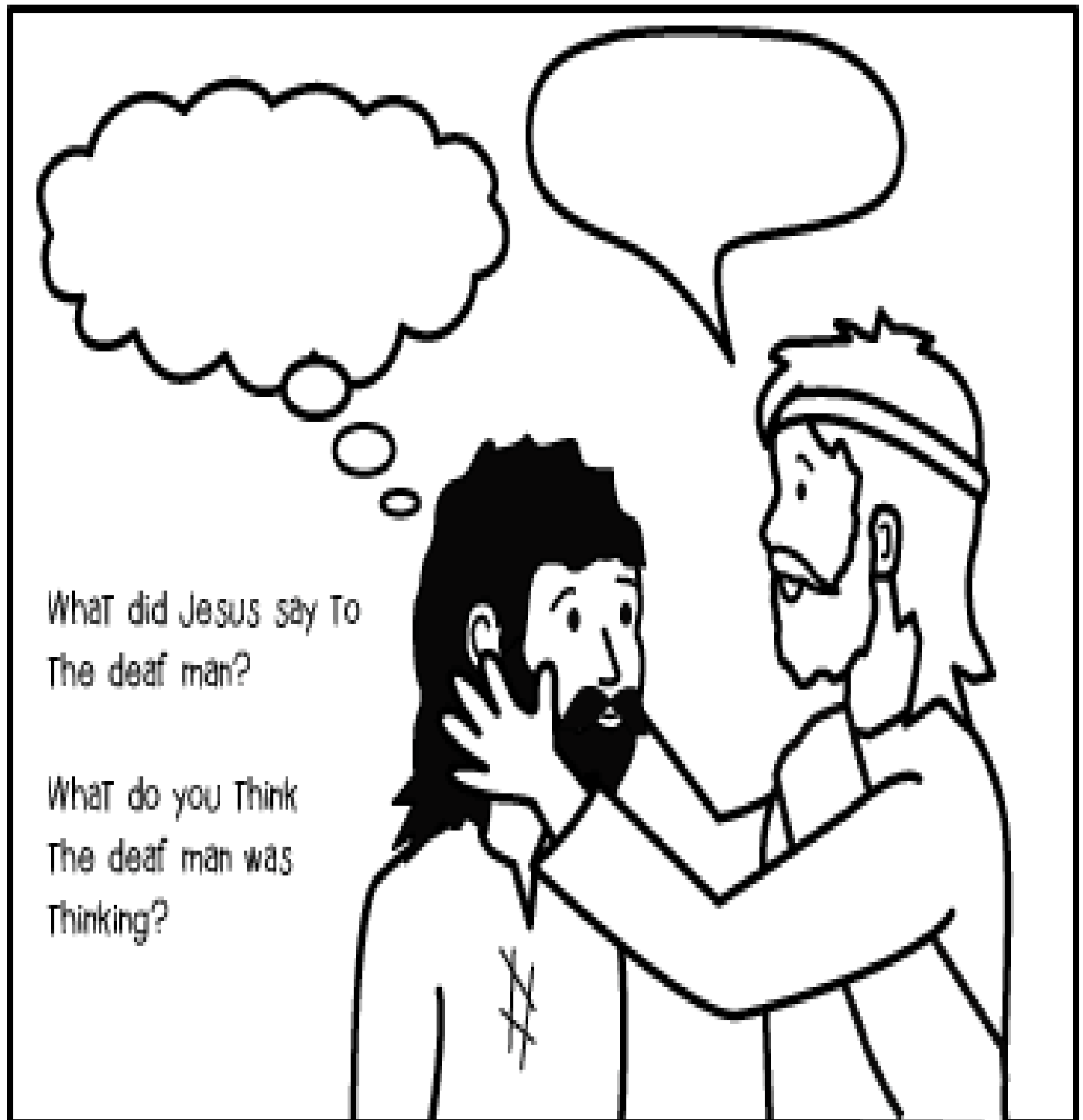

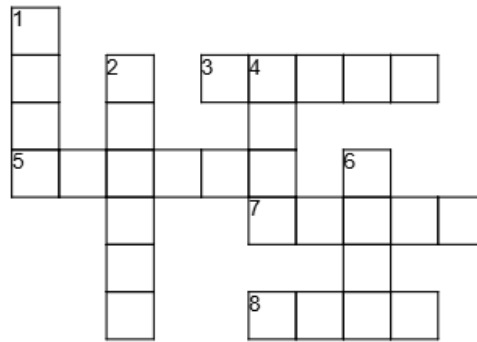
