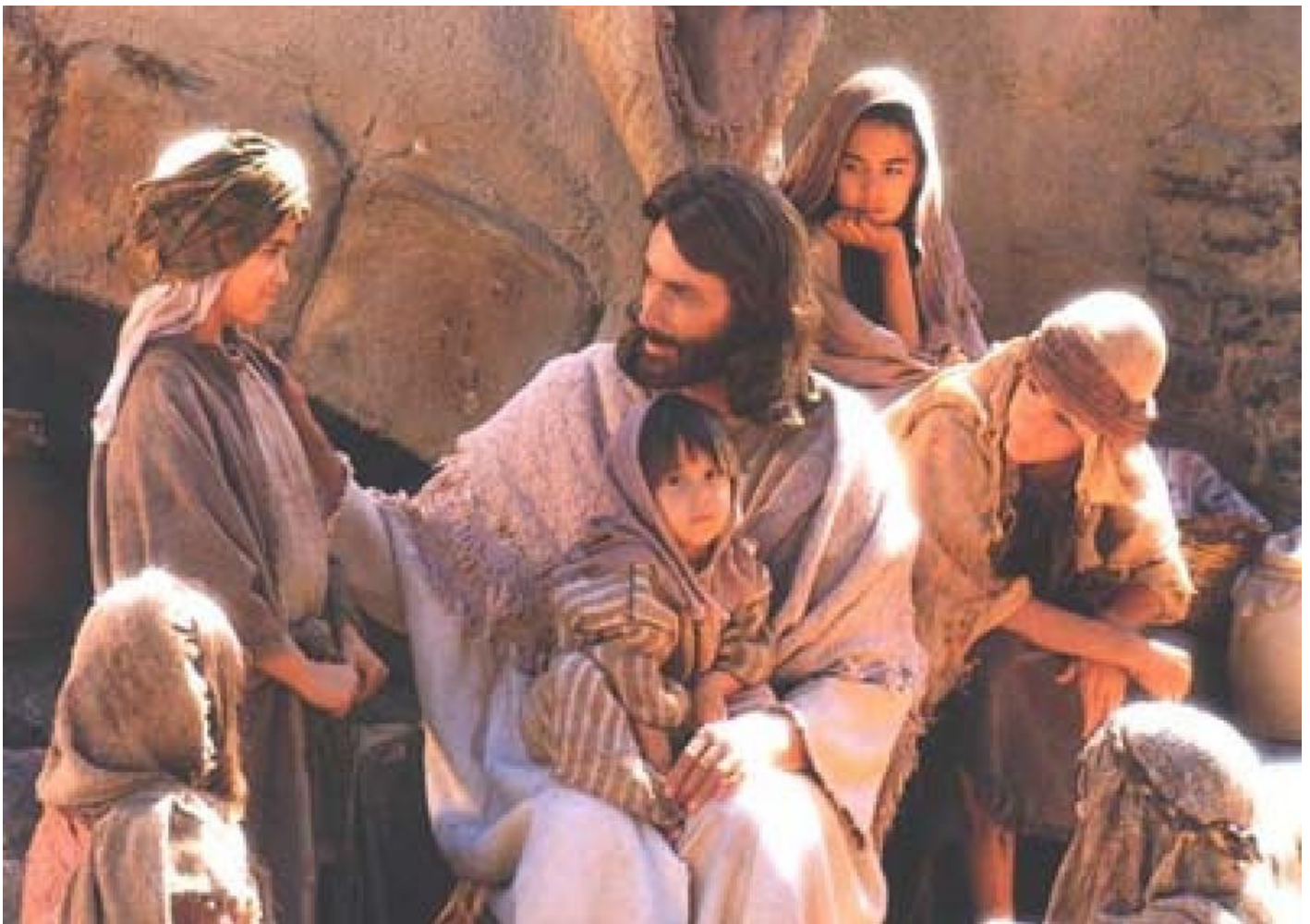

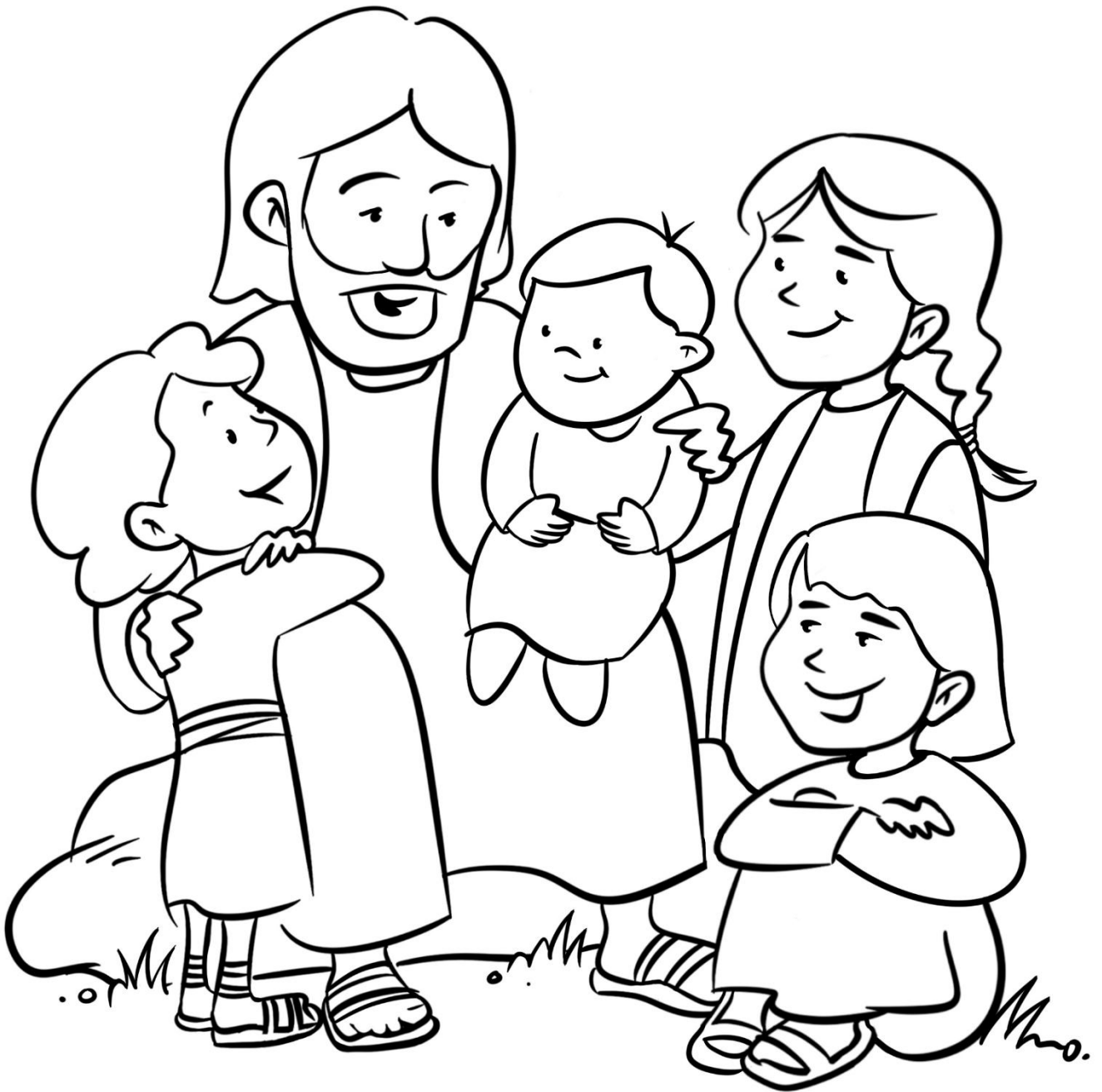
Let's always remember how Jesus loved the children and took them into His loving arms.

Prayer

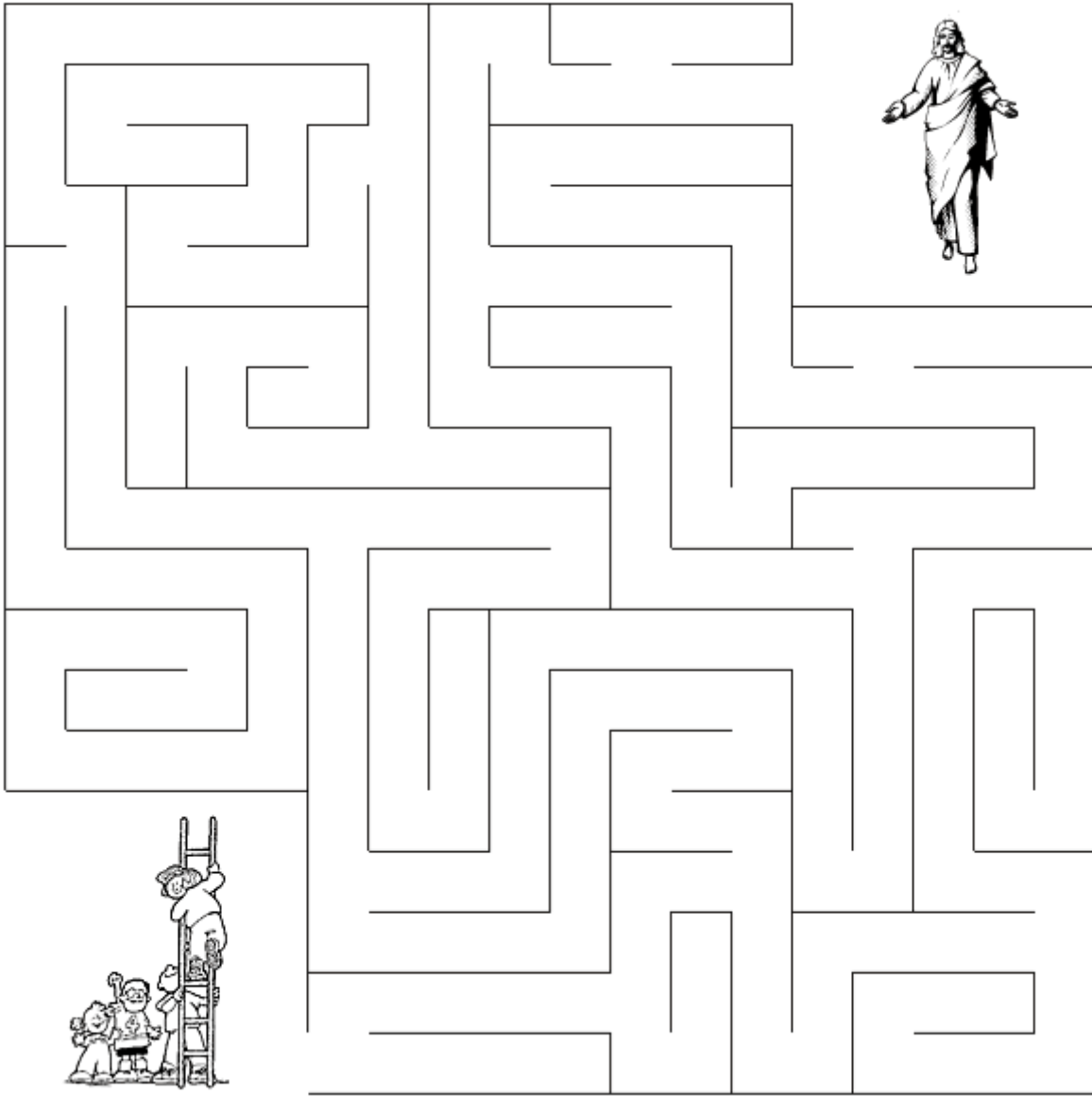
Dear God, Please help us all to come to Jesus as little children.

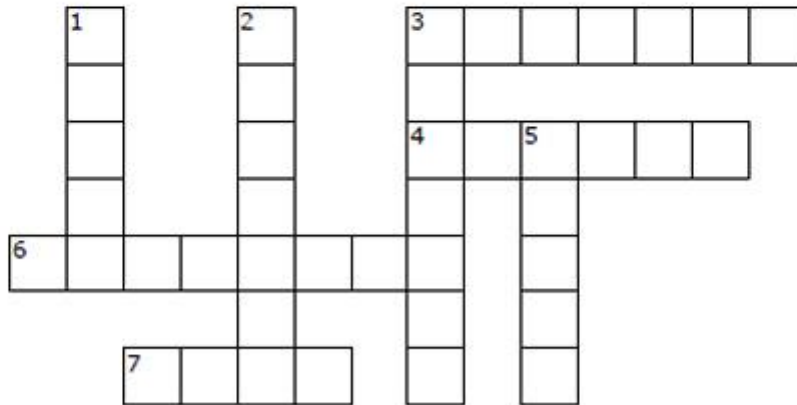
